

Evaluation

Music, Dance, Drama: Performances will be evaluated by specialists in the fields and each student will receive a written copy of that evaluation.

Awards: Performers will receive keepsake a medal.

Judging

Literature and Visual Arts: Entries will be judged competitively by out-of-county judges **prior** to Youth Art Day. Grade level grouping for judging purposes: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12.

Literature entries and applications must be delivered to PCCA by 2/27/09. Winners will be notified prior to Youth Art Day and invited to read.

Visual Art entries and applications must be delivered to PCCA by 2/27/09. Judging will take place before Youth Art Day. All entries will be included in the exhibit. Visual Art **winners** will be announced at 3 p.m. on April 25th in the auditorium.

Awards: All visual and literary participants will receive ribbons; winners will receive keepsake medals.

- Performance time is limited to four (4) minutes, drama up to ten (10) minutes. Please consult your teacher about an appropriate selection and contact PCCA for approval of extra time.
- For a group performance, each individual must submit an application form and \$3 entry fee. List the other members of the group on your application.
- Selections may be original or the creation of another person. **Please inform the audience of the author's name and the title of the work.**

Music application

Performance Specification:

- Total performance time should be no more than six (6) minutes, unless PCCA grants a time extension.
- Plan to perform two or more **contrasting pieces**. Beginning students are encouraged to consult teachers for appropriate music.
- Vocalists should plan to perform at least two (2) selections.
- You may either bring your accompanist or a home recording of your accompaniment. **No commercial accompaniments are acceptable.**
- **Provide clean original sheet music for the evaluators**, who will not accept photocopies, as they violate copyright law. Put your name on **all sheet music and books and bring for registration the day of event.**
- Memorization is encouraged, but reading is acceptable and has no negative effect on evaluation. Be sure to bring an extra set for yourself.
- For a group performance, each performer must submit an application form and \$3 entry fee, and list the other members of the group.

Rules / Requirements:

- Student may submit only one application per literary category; maximum three entries. \$3 fee, per entry.
- Maximum word limit—2000 words.
- Submit only original, unpublished work written since April 1, 2008.
- A separate cover page must accompany each entry with the following information: Full Name, Grade, School, Category, and Title.
- Entries **must** be typed, double-spaced on plain white, 8-1/2" x 11" paper (no artwork).
- Staple multiple pages together in the upper left corner.
- Applications and entry must be received at the PCCA Gallery, One S. Second St., Newport by Friday, February 27, 2009.
- Entries must be submitted unfolded. Be sure to keep a copy for yourself.
- The winning Literature entries become the property of PCCA and may be submitted for publication in local newspapers. Winning writers are invited to read their work at Youth Art Day; please bring an additional copy from which to read.

General Information

Youth Art Day 2009

Youth Art Day is an arts festival for Perry County students! It is a day intended to showcase talented young people in five disciplines: Visual Arts, Music, Literature, Dance, and Drama.

Youth Art Day on April 25th begins with **registration** for **Music, Dance** and **Drama** from 12:00 noon until 1:00 p.m. Performances begin at approximately 1:15 p.m. Literature and Visual Art Exhibits will be open from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m. The Awards Ceremony for Visual Art and Literature winners begins at approximately 3:15 p.m. Refreshments and snacks will be sold from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m. There is a \$3 admission fee for the general public. Students are admitted free.

Eligibility: All Perry County residents in kindergarten through 12th grade are invited to participate. Students may attend public or private school, in or out of the county, or be home schooled.

Entry Fee: All applications require a non-refundable \$3 entry fee. Any entry submitted without the required fee or information will be ineligible.
