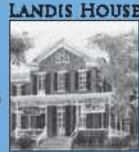
The Artist

Quilting artist Denise Hoke has spent more than 35 years studying with veteran Amish, Mennonite and modern journeymen quilters. Since 1978, she has maintained her own studio in Perry County and has been a residency and teaching artist with Perry County Council of the Arts (PCCA) for more than 10 years. She regularly participates in juried art and craft shows, selling her original quilts and wall hangings, and oversees hands-on community quilting projects at the Little Buffalo Festival and the Mifflin-Juniata Arts Festival. In 1998, Denise was recognized as PCCA's Artist of the Year.
