This fiscal year was full of many changes and outstanding progress toward our strategic plan. With this publication, we move into an annual report format, formerly bi-annual.

Staffing and volunteer leadership changes are the largest change an organization can experience, and ours brought fresh perspective to PCCA's strategic direction.

Our board leadership, in seeking a new Executive Director, sought a leader with a combination of business and nonprofit experience, experience with staff development, experience in developing a board, experience in strategic planning, and the enthusiasm to fulfill our mission. With this in mind, Erika Juran began serving as Executive Director in March of 2017. After a time of overlap with the outgoing Director, Roger Smith, Erika took hold of the brush and began filling our canvas with exactly that experience, creativity and exuberance for mission that we, as a board, desired.

Our staff team development included the creation of a Communication Director role. Our Gallery Director, Missy Smith, ably stepped into this role. She immediately had the support both from our staff and a specially funded training cohort group of just 24 selected participants known as "National Arts Marketing for the 21st Century". This training is conducted by Americans for the Arts and is an ongoing resource for both our Communications Director and Executive Director whom attend. Our Artist Engagement program, supported by gallery and program staff including Gallery Assistant Kim McMullen, has helped begin connecting and listening to our member artists.

Our Board entered into funded and strategic training and development this summer. First, Pennsylvania Association of Nonprofit Organizations facilitated a day long training to help the board understand its responsibilities, group development, and best practices. Next, a building and collections assessment of Landis House, through a grant from the Foundation of the American Institute for Conservation of Historic and Artistic Works. With the support of Finance and Landis House Manager, Teena Beutel helped the Board understand needed short, mid, and long-range goals to effectively steward this wonderful gift. Finally, the strategic assessment of Board committees will help the board move toward its goals, which include a marketing and development plan spearheaded by the rebirth of the development committee.

Our new and expanded programming, under the care of Creative Programs Director Jasmine Colbert, helped provide more movement towards greater accessibility of our community programs. These included an expanded Drop-In Art program, now held in 2 locations and coordinated by Janice Bailor, and our first ever Summer Art Camp! Under the care of volunteer coordinator Diane Witcoski, our Art on Tour program helped expand the exhibition opportunities of our member artists to over nine offsite spaces throughout Central PA.

When we updated our three year Strategic Plan in January 2018, we recognize that our trajectory to continue providing programming and artist development in our seven county service area is robust. This is due in no small part to the support of our dedicated, talented, creative, and growing membership base, which we will work to engage further in the coming year. Thank you so much for being a part of Building Community Through the Arts.

Thanks to a generous grant from the Foundation of the American Institute for Conservation, assessors Andrew Fearon and John Hartmann provided a **collections and building assessment of Landis House**, intended to recommend directions and opportunities for PCCA leaders to help steward these gifts into the future.

The event included the Newport VFW and Legion and a recognition of the newest historical markers of Perry County. Nine Quilt Barn Murals created through Arts in Residency Pennsylvania Council on the Arts Partnership projects in Juniata schools since 2013 were hung on Juniata County barns in summer 2017, thus christening our Perry Juniata Quilt Barn Trail, now twenty-two murals strong. The expanded Trail received much press coverage in summer and fall 2017, and attracted tourists to our area, including a multi-coach bus tour of quilters.

Thanks to generous grants from McCormick Family, the Margetts Foundation, and Arts for All Partnership, a collaboration between The Foundation for Enhancing Communities and the Cultural Enrichment Fund, our **Drop-In Art program expanded** to two monthly locations in Perry County, and attendance numbers grew to as many as 35 per location.



Hosted bi-monthly at a Perry County restaurant or winery, PCCA's **Coffeehouse open mic experienced a successful resurgence** of performers, including talented high school students showcasing their original poetry and music. The revitalization of this event series can be attributed to the changing weekday schedule, engaging young performers, rotating the event geographically throughout the county, planning meetings, promotion and attractive venue offerings.

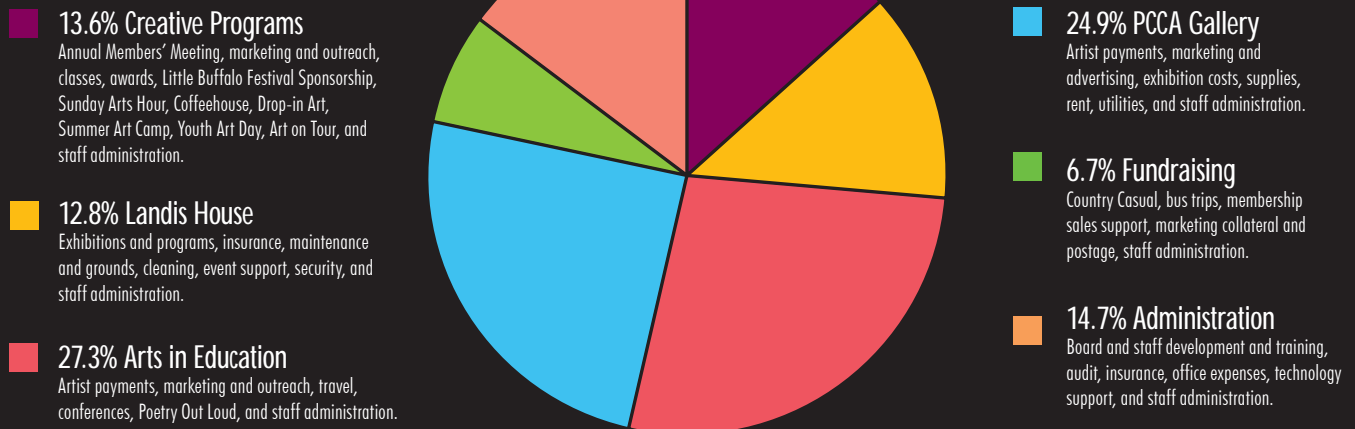

Our **first ever Summer Art Camp**, held in early August, attracted 32 first-sixth graders from 3 counties for a week of fun planned by 5 local art educators, who explored painting, poetry, video, drama, and musical instruments.



In January 2016, PCCA **celebrated the release of "Strange Magic"**, an anthology of short stories by faculty and students of PCCA's A Novel Idea writing program. Each short story was a take on the writer's vivid thoughts, images and moments that are real, surreal and fantastical. Strange Magic was edited by A Novel Idea faculty member Catherine Jordan and designed and published by Sunbury Press of Mechanicsburg.

The students had the benefit of meeting an internationally selling artist that lives right here in Perry County and learned that having a career in art is possible.



With the added support of artist, Art on Tour volunteer coordinator and board member Diane Witcoski, our **Art on Tour program expanded** to 9 offsite locations, including Carson Long Military Academy, the Capitol Building in Harrisburg, and the Whitaker Center for Science and the Arts, providing greater exhibition offerings for our professional member artists and awarded students at Youth Art Day 2017.
