In 2007, the Perry County Council of the Arts inherited Landis House, a 5,000- square-foot mansion, and the numerous artworks and artifacts from the Estate of Mary M. Landis.

The mission of Landis House is to serve the community as a Creative Commons, offering a contemporary gallery which provides exhibit opportunities to established and emerging artists, a

recital and concert hall for novice and professional musicians, a venue to display historically relevant artifacts in the form of a permanent collection from the life and travels of the Landis Family (in honor of Arthur Clair and Bertha Rippman Landis, the parents of Mary M. Landis), and as a resource promoting community building programs, be it through classes, lectures, readings, and meetings that work in tandem with the overall interests of Perry County Council of the Arts.



Perry County Council of the Arts (PCCA) also operates PCCA Gallery, showcasing the fine artwork of more than 190 of the region's talented artisans.

While our name implies that we are a county arts council, PCCA has a regional impact – drawing in working artists, poets and musicians from all over Central Pennsylvania. Perry County Council of the Arts also partners with the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts to implement artist residencies in seven counties. In addition, we provide a host of local programs to our immediate community.

Whether you are in our neighborhood, or you are hearing of us for the first time, the board and staff of Perry County Council of the Arts welcome the opportunity to showcase your artwork!

*Enhanced Thrift Art* is an exhibition of artwork, with each visual art entry beginning as a piece of art or article found at a thrift store/yard sale or in your long ago forgotten storage area.

The goal is to give neglected and abandoned art a makeover. You may draw on it, paint on it, collage on it, sew on it, or cut it up. Make it your own! We are looking for two-dimensional and three-dimensional entries that include, but are not limited to pictures, sculptures, clothing, or jewelry. Entries due January 25.

**January 15:** Submit written materials and photo via email (preferred) or deliver to PCCA.

**January 21-25:** Deliver labeled items to Landis House along with this completed entry form.

**February 8 - March 29:** Exhibition dates

**February 8, 5:30 to 7:30 pm:** Artists' Reception. Your attendance is encouraged. Please bring a refreshment to share.

**April 1 - 5:** Dates to pick up your artwork.

## Entry Specifications

*Enhanced Thrift Art* is open to members and non-members of Perry County Council of the Arts. Non-members must pay \$10 per entry, \$5 for students. Checks made payable to PCCA.

### Eligibility

- Elements that you have contributed to the existing piece must be original in both concept and execution and created by the submitting artist.
- Hanging entries must be wired and compatible with Landis House's display system.
- Framed artwork may not exceed 36" in either direction, unless authorized by the curator.
- You may enter up to three pieces; however, all entries are ultimately subject to the decision of the curator.
- PCCA may use images from the exhibit for promotional purposes in newspapers, within newsletters, on Facebook and on the PCCA website. Full copyright acknowledgement will be given whenever possible.
- Participants are encouraged to attend the opening reception on Friday, February 8, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at Landis House.

## Reclamation & Sales Policy

Perry County Council of the Arts (PCCA) provides its members with exhibiting opportunities which are a key stepping stone in the career of any artist. To help promote growth and development, PCCA retains only a 35% commission on works sold through exhibits curated by PCCA. This is much lower than the industry standard, and affords emerging artists flexibility to develop their pricing structure and gives established artists the opportunity to grow their studio practice.

We encourage artists to indicate a **sale price** (the "sticker price" of the artwork, not what you hope to retain from the sale) on the attached entry form, along with the corresponding title as indicated on your piece of art.

Payment for sold items will be included in a check. It is encouraged that all work remain on display in the exhibition until the Reclamation Period begins.

Works that are not sold must be reclaimed within a timely fashion. **The dates for pickup for *Enhanced Thrift Art* are April 1-5, 2019. Items left behind after April 30, 2019 will be considered abandoned.**
