<p>October 18, 2019 - January 11, 2020</p>	<p>Artisan Marketplace will be on display and open to the public. PCCA Gallery is CLOSED on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.</p>
<p>Cost to Artists</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$15 participation fee(\$5 for existing PCCA members)</li> <li>• PCCA will retain 35% of sales and pay sales tax. Payments will be mailed the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month for all items sold during the previous month. (ie. November 20, December 20, January 20)</li> </ul>
<p>January 18, 2020</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At the conclusion of the display, artists are invited to join PCCA for an additional \$15 to continue their relationship. This must be completed by January 11, 2020.</li> <li>• Those not joining must remove their products by January 13, 2019. Work left beyond this date becomes property of PCCA. Members may continue exhibiting.</li> </ul>
