## Entry Specifications

*Art Uplifts* is open to entries of 2D & 3D artwork by members of Perry County Council of the Arts. There is no cost to submit entries to this special public exhibition! To become a Perry County Council of the Arts member, call 717-567-7023 or visit [perrycountyarts.org](http://perrycountyarts.org).

### Eligibility

- Work must be original in both concept and execution and created by the submitting artist.
- You may enter up to 3 entries for consideration, but we aim to choose 1 piece of art per artist for the outdoor exhibition. In the case that we have limited entries, an artist may have multiple entries accepted. All entries will be considered for the *Art Uplifts* online exhibition, where artwork will be available for purchase. Please be sure that your work is framed and/or ready for sale at the start of the exhibition.
- PCCA may use images from the exhibition for promotional purposes in newspapers and newsletters, on social media and on our website. Full copyright acknowledgement will be given whenever possible.

## Sales Policy

Perry County Council of the Arts (PCCA) provides the regional community with exhibiting opportunities that are key stepping stones in the career of any artist. To help promote growth and development, PCCA retains only a 35% commission on works sold through exhibitions curated by PCCA. This is much lower than the industry standard, and affords emerging artists flexibility to develop their pricing structure and gives established artists the opportunity to grow their studio practice.

We encourage artists to indicate a sale price (the "sticker price" of available original artwork, and not what you hope to retain from the sale) on the attached **Entry Form**. Please be prepared to deliver any sold items to PCCA Gallery within 2 weeks of notification of purchase.

Payment for sold items will be included in a check, which will be mailed to the artist.

### Artist Statement/Quote/Short Poem

Provide a statement, quote or poem about each entry (limit 75 words), including the meaning or significance of each piece, as it relates to the theme of the show. This statement will be printed on one side of the yard sign with your name medium/town/website, and your art image will be printed on the other side. You may submit a longer description, poem, short story, etc., for inclusion in the digital exhibition.

### Digital Artwork Images

Please email:

- 1 Hi-resolution images (300 dpi) of just your artwork to be placed on the outdoor signs be used as product imagery for online sales.
- 2 Hi-resolution product style images that include framing or other accessories. These images will be used as product imagery for online sales.
