## MISSION | Building community through the arts

Perry County Council of the Arts accomplishes our mission by encouraging the creative spirit in adults and children, supporting artists and celebrating their successes, enhancing the local economy, and implementing enriching Arts in Education initiatives throughout 7 Central PA counties.

PCCA board, staff and volunteers strive to fulfill the mission by helping artists become more economically viable, encouraging adults and young people to explore various art forms and providing local programs that community members can join as participants or members of an audience.

## CORE PROGRAMS | Connect people in our community

Through a partnership with Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, PCCA administers **Arts in Education** residencies in 7 counties—Perry, Juniata, Mifflin, Montour, Snyder, Union and Northumberland—linking professional artists with schools, senior facilities, libraries, and other organizations, in-person and virtually for a 5+ day experience. Participants collaborate on a project for a culminating event, private installation or public art piece.

Our **Community Programs** serve audiences of all ages with artistic opportunities that are often low cost, free, or discounted to PCCA members. These include classes; poetry and book readings; PerryLive! performances; Coffeehouse open mic nights; Drop-In Art; and Summer Art Camps.

**PCCA Gallery** staff provides sales and marketing support to Central PA artists and makers of every discipline and skill level. Member artists can display and sell their works at PCCA Gallery, Landis House exhibitions, Art on Tour traveling displays, and online while having access to artist development workshops and the new artist resource room at PCCA Gallery.

Mary Landis donated **Landis House** to PCCA in 2007 at the time of her death, in honor of her parents. PCCA hosts rotating exhibitions, classes, concerts, art camps, community meetings, and other events at Landis House, while displaying Landis Family art and artifacts.

## LIVES IMPACTED | 40,000

People of all ages, backgrounds, skill levels and walks of life engage in the arts through Perry County Council of the Arts' community arts programming. An estimated 40,000 people have viewed artwork, enjoyed a performance, or taken a class in Perry County and the Central PA region.

# FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

What a difference a year makes!

After enduring the Covid pandemic, we feel a renewed sense of energy. PCCA staff and volunteers have been working hard to provide funding and programming for the communities we serve. In large and small ways, we are making a difference.

This year, in cooperation with the Perry County Economic Development Authority, we received a \$50,000 Our Town Award from the National Endowment for the Arts to support a countywide public art initiative. This initiative will draw on community ideas and support to create cultural enhancements within the county's boroughs.

Youth art programming abounds through our Arts in Education partnership with the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts within our seven county footprint, and via increased summer art camps including theatre, cooking, dance, digital media, art in nature and journaling here in Perry County. As an approved Educational Improvement Organization, we are eligible to receive designated tax-deductible contributions from participating corporations toward innovative arts programming for public school students in K-12.

In addition, our member artists are represented via an upgraded PCCA Gallery webstore. They have access to peer networking and professional development, as well as the Art on Tour traveling art program. Community members of all ages continue to enjoy inclusive art classes, live performances and open mics, regular exhibitions, and workshops.

Lastly, we celebrated our 40th anniversary! We remain a vital part of the community by the hard work and support of our members, staff, and volunteers. Because of you, we are well positioned for many more years of service to Perry County and surrounding communities.

# 2021-2022 Programming

## Art for All Ages and Abilities

**Drop-In Art** provided resources for families to craft together using instructional and fun videos available on YouTube and through in-person sessions at popular community events. Costumed families gathered in the Landis House courtyard for Spooky Storytelling, treats and crafts in late October. A summer process art class brought pre-schoolers to the Landis art room.

**Inclusive Art Classes** at Landis House brought together 70 community members who are living with and without developmental and intellectual disabilities to interact, form friendships and share a fun, encouraging experience. Projects included candlemaking, puppetmaking, eggshell mosaics, and printmaking led by teaching artist Tom Oakes.

**Summer Art Camps** welcomed 65 campers aged 5-16 for week-long experiences and new friendships. A youth favorite was presented by Cove Mountain Community Theatre and Bloomsburg Theatre Ensemble where campers learned about choreography, stage makeup, costumes, acting and the technical departments. Other topics included Art in Nature, Cooking, Digital Media, Dance and Art Journaling.

**Youth Art Day** featured the work of 1,098 Perry County school students in Kindergarten through 12th grade in a visual art and literary display paired with creative family activities at Greenwood High School. The annual student art showcase awarded top prizes in each visual and literary category, as well as an overall Best-In-Show winner and People's Choice Award.

## Artist Development and Exhibition Opportunities

**PCCA Gallery** provided display and retail space for 200 emerging and professional artists who had access to regular in-store and online representation, customer feedback, and connections to additional creative opportunities in the area. Member artists were featured in themed and solo exhibits within the downtown Newport location and included "Art of a Pandemic," "Artisan Marketplace," "Natural Elements," "Good Taste," and "Frame of Mind." In early June, the gallery was challenged by water damage that forced closure to the public. The unfortunate event turned into a catalyst to convert the inventory management and point of sale system, a necessary upgrade that was on our wishlist. PCCA Gallery generated \$56,315 in sales during 2021-2022.

**Art on Tour** provided member artists with additional display opportunities in locations throughout our community including Babs Curran Senior Center, Duncannon; Buffalo Brew, Pennian Bank, and Sisson-Boyer Eyecare, Newport; Farmers Daughters Cafe and Perry County Chamber of Commerce, New Bloomfield; and The State Capitol of Pennsylvania, Harrisburg.

In its second year, **Art Uplifts**, an outdoor facet of the Art on Tour program, featured the artwork of 15 members and Youth Art Day students on 29 printed yard signs exhibited at Veterans Memorial Park and Little Buffalo State Park, Newport; and Millerstown Community Park, Millerstown. An estimated 1,000 viewed the displays.

**Art Talk & Social Hour** kicked off its inaugural professional development gathering with 19 artists who learned from Susquehanna Art Museum's Lauren Nye about tips for catching a juror's eye when applying to exhibitions.

## Economic Development

**Our Town** project planning began in July during the Perry County Economic Development Authority's regular Main Street meetings. Through community engagement and the direction of qualified artists, PCCA will oversee the installation of public art in each of the nine Perry County boroughs.

**Ladies' Night** celebrated its 14<sup>th</sup> year, drawing out the crowds for an evening of shopping and exploring Newport's small businesses on the second Friday of November.



## Arts in Education Partnership

As one of 14 regional partners of the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, PCCA implements quality arts experiences in classroom and community settings in seven Central PA counties.

A **Koi Fish Mosaic** project took place over the course of two weeks with teaching artist Linda Billet leading more than 90 students and staff at Susquenita Middle School in creating a permanent fused glass mosaic. With Billet's support, students created their own fused glass tiles. Once enough tiles were created, she guided the students in laying the tiles across three panels to create the design of koi fish swimming together. Students were involved in all aspects of the project – from glass cutting to arranging to applying the grout. The mosaic was installed in the hallway as a permanent fixture at the school.



## Performances

PCCA's **Coffeehouse Open Mic Nights** are different in a good way -- the audience truly listens and is encouraging to performers of all ages and abilities! Attendees can expect to hear poems sprinkled among instrumental offerings with the occasional story tossed. Restaurants and venues throughout Perry County graciously host the typically bi-monthly events.

**PerryLive!** performances presented local and regional musicians at Landis House including Rebecca Covert (cabaret), Charlie Zahm (Celtic music and storytelling), DP Kahl (saxophone) and Zach Nyce (piano).



## Advocacy & Fundraising

**Arts Advocacy Day** was held in May with a chance to meet legislators and attend an arts caucus. One of the highlights was hearing a performance by PA native Victory Brinker who is the Guinness World Record's Youngest Opera Singer.

**Local Treasures** remains PCCA's fundraising event of the year. Donors and guests contributed to PCCA's annual operating budget while enjoying a catered brunch, live music, adult beverages and raffles at The Winery at Hunters Valley.

A **Garden Party** rental preview in May unveiled the use of Landis House as an intimate rental space, and an additional generator of unrestricted income.

**Match Madness** served as our annual call for funds with matching potential.



## Something to Celebrate

PCCA's Annual Membership Meeting & Awards took place in the form of a picnic at Millerstown Community Park where members of all ages celebrated our organization's 40th anniversary in June. Senior Artistic Award recipient, Allie Fritz, performed during the event. Throughout the 2021-2022 year, we recognized more than 32 awardees for their achievements in the arts.

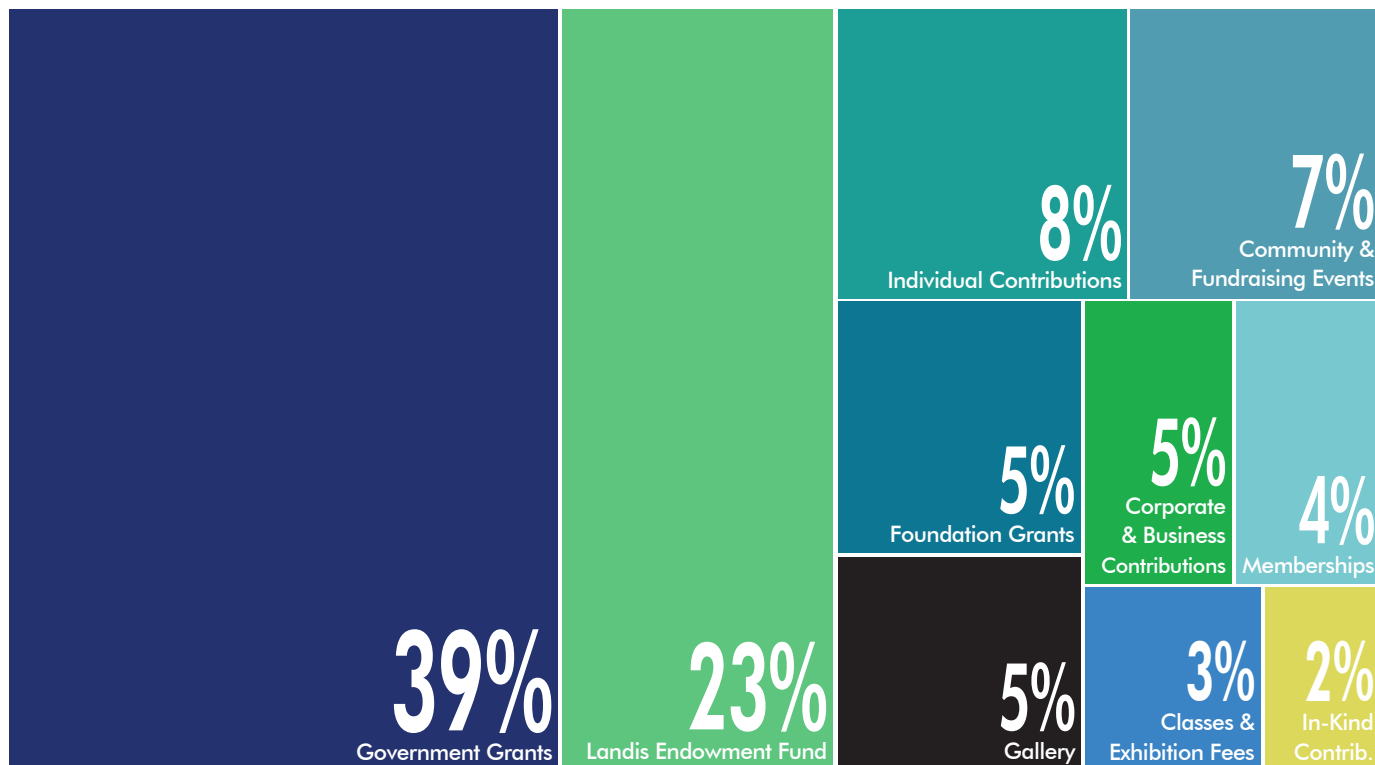

### \$377,679

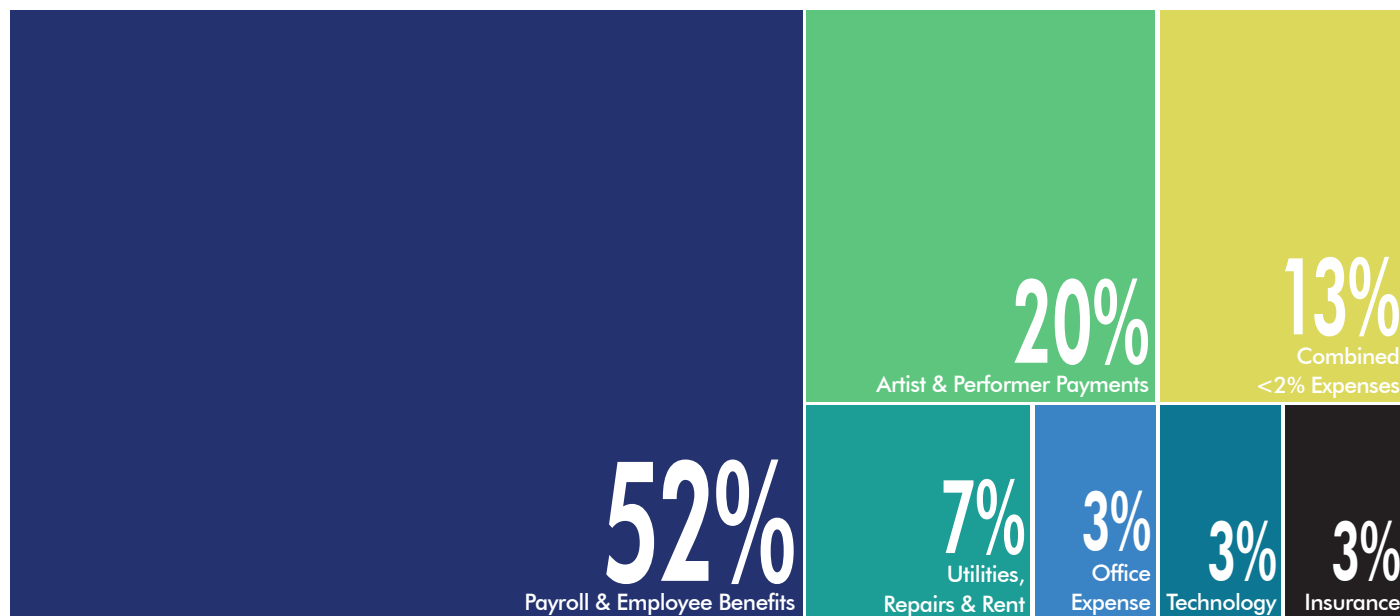
