

Summer Art Camp 2023 INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in summer art camps presented by Perry County Council of the Arts (PCCA). Please review the following information carefully. We have added several new camps, age ranges, times, and locations this year. Camp sizes are generally limited to 12 students and are on a first come first serve basis. If you are interested in attending camp(s), please complete and return your registration form(s) by April 24th, 2023.

Registration

Camp sessions fill up fast! Please register promptly to ensure your camper has a spot. After a session is filled, we will keep a waiting list in case of cancellations. To register, complete the registration form marking an X for the session(s) your camper plans to attend. Additional camps may become available please refer to link/site above. For families with multiple children, each camper needs their own form. You may complete registration online or by mail/email. Confirmation of your camp session registration or waiting list status will be provided via email shortly after we have received completed registration.

Tuition Payment

If you have an active PCCA family membership, you can apply a 10% discount per weekly session. All checks should be made payable to **PCCA**. Payments may also be made online- utilize the discount code for the member rates (please call if you need this). Cancellation of a camp will result in a \$20 reduction of your registration fee refund (per camp/per child) if you do not notify PCCA at least 3 weeks prior to the camps start date. The remaining monies will be refunded based on your original payment method.

Scholarships

Financial assistance is available. Request one by selecting the box on the registration form. All forms received will be in consideration for scholarship funds.

Arrival and Pick-up

Campers should arrive no more than 15 minutes before the start of camp. A pre-authorized adult will sign in each day with a member of camp staff. Students should be picked up no later than 15 minutes after the end time of camp. Authorized adult must present photo ID during pick-up and sign out with camp staff. Siblings are not considered an authorized adult unless over the age 17.

Instructors

Art camp instructors are teaching artists who are either members of PCCA's Arts in Education roster, members of community organizations or teach classes for nearby schools and art centers. Each instructor maintains necessary clearances.

Volunteers & Staff

PCCA approved volunteers and staff members may be present to facilitate camp. If you would like to volunteer at camp, please check the box on the registration form and we will be in touch.

Lunch and Snacks

Each day- All campers should bring filled water bottle and a snack.

Half-Day Camp (3 hours): Campers will be offered one (1) snack break.

Full-Day Camp: Campers will be offered (1) snack break and (1) lunch break. A packed lunch is necessary.

Health and Emergency Policy

In case of a medical emergency or an accident, we will contact the parents of the child, or the alternate contact person listed on the child's registration form. If contacts cannot be reached in an emergency, your child will be transported to the nearest medical facility. If a child becomes ill or mildly injured, the parents will be notified and asked to pick up their child, if necessary. If your child will not be attending a camp day(s) due to illness, please notify PCCA as soon as possible so we know not to expect them.

COVID-19 Safety

PCCA continues to closely follow updates and guidance from the CDC and PA Department of Health. Campers and staff safety is our priority, and we will take measures as needed if changes occur. To maintain a healthy environment for all summer art camps, we ask that you monitor the health of your camper daily. I understand that I must complete, sign, and date the registration form and mail, email, or deliver it to the Perry County Council of the Arts along with full tuition payment for the camp session(s) in full by April 24, 2023, to complete my registration. I understand that camp is filled on a first-come basis and that if filled or canceled by PCCA I will be issued a full refund. I understand that PCCA reserves the right to discontinue my child's enrollment without refund due to improper behavior. I give PCCA authorization to reproduce my child's image and artwork created by my child during the program for the purposes of program publicity and fundraising. I will not hold PCCA responsible for clothing or personal items dirtied or damaged while in camp. I agree to assess my child's health each morning and will notify PCCA immediately if my child has any symptoms of illness while keeping them at home. I will not hold Perry County Council of the Arts responsible for any accident or injury incurred by my child during a PCCA activity. If I cannot be reached in case of an emergency, permission is given to the instructor or PCCA authority to take my child to the doctor, hospital, or emergency care facility.
