Meet our Instructors

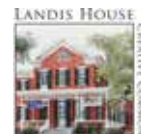

BEHIND THE SCENES

with PCCA stained glass artist *Brian Fleegee*

I'm originally from Northwest PA and have been working in glass for about 18 years! My background isn't very "artsy" in the traditional sense. I earned my degree in computer science and engineering -- that's the field I currently work in. My background in a technological field helps me to understand and follow the technical steps involved in my craft. When working with stained glass, everything can be planned out and organized into steps. I use the skills I learned during a photography class when I make a pattern in my glass work -- how to compose an image, the rule of thirds, and what makes something pleasant to look at.

"I am a craftsman when putting it together, and an artist when picking out the glass and color."

I've always enjoyed stained glass. I remember going to church when I was younger and looking at the beautiful stained glass windows. Later, I bought my first house and knew I wanted to put (stained) glass in it. I took an intro to glass class with the West Shore Community Recreation Program, and that's when I

knew I LOVED IT! I've always liked the beauty, the color, the process.

Inspired by the iconic Tiffany Lamps by L.C. Tiffany and Clara Driscoll's work, I tend to incorporate floral imagery and historic themes in my work. Clara was the head of Tiffany's women's glass cutting department. She was also the designer of several of Tiffany's most popular lamp designs, such as the Dragonfly, Wisteria, and Peony shades.

I prefer to use "Art Glass" made by the Kokomo Opalescent Glass Co. in Kokomo, IN and glass made by the Youghioghney Opalescent Glass Company, Inc. which is in Connellsville, PA. I've actually been to their factory more than once, and that's where I pick out and directly buy the glass I use in my work. I like art glass because it has more diversity, fluidity and texture as opposed to cathedral glass which is used in church windows. I don't have a favorite tool per se, but my most important tool is my soldering iron!

In the near future I'm hoping to get into fusing glass with my art practice. I have a kiln, and my wife and I will be taking a class soon to learn how to use it and run all the different programs you can use for glass fusing, as well as obtaining information on how to use glass molds. I'm excited to see what direction this will take my art.

My advice to those interested in learning a new craft -- learn hands on! Find people and teachers who are experts at their craft and learn from them, then take what you learn and make it your own. Be aware of the structure and reason behind the process. This will help you more than you know.

There are a lot of resources available to you, like youtube, art facebook groups, and books! Learning from knowledgeable people is helpful, but hands-on learning is BEST! Both in learning and seeing your results as you're making.

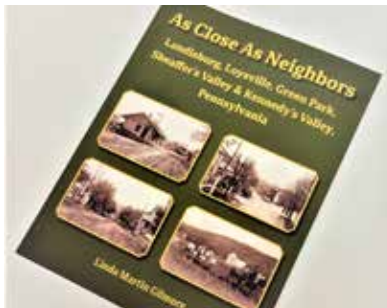

DROP-IN ART

Excerpt of Perry County Times article

In January, Perry County Council of the Arts launched its Preschool Visiting Artist program, which is an extension of the Drop-In Art program that has been running since June 2015. The program allows artists to present their work in preschools as children see how art is made. A simplified project follows, which lets the children explore the visiting artist's medium.

Thus far, the program has held events at Roseglen Christian Nursery School and Perry County Generations in Shermans Dale and Duncannon. The events at Roseglen were an introduction to photography and collage, the event at Perry County Generations in Shermans Dale was an introduction to printmaking, and the one planned for Duncannon is an introduction to woodworking.

Each event features a guest artist who is introduced to the children. The artist will deliver an explanation of their work followed by a brief demonstration. Bailor follows the demonstration with an artistic activity that serves as a simplification of the medium of the guest artist. Students finish up by sharing their work, discussing and cleaning up.

"My favorite part of teaching the class is seeing a kid's eyes and face light up when they discover they can create a little magic with their own hands and imagination," Bailor said.

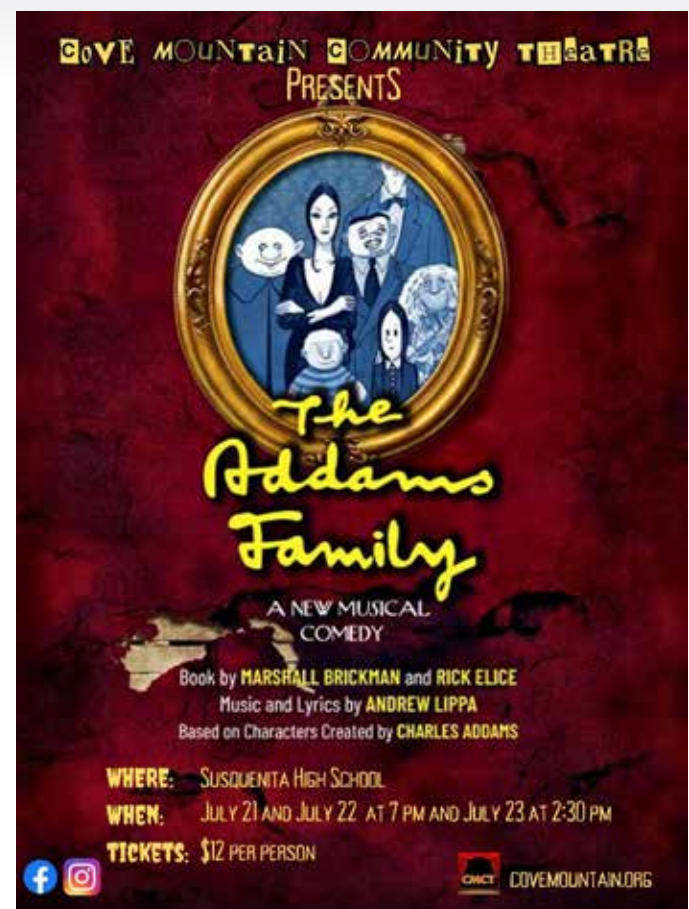
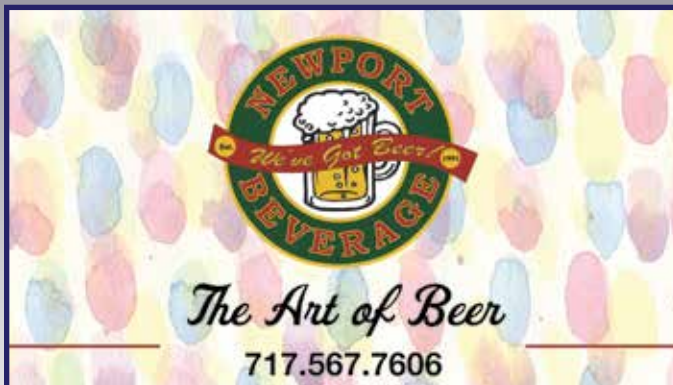
