To register your students, complete the following steps:

Step 1: Submit completed excel list of entries to PCCA by Feb. 7, 2024 for processing

Step 2: Affix PCCA provided People's Choice labels to front of student visual art entries

Step 3: Schedule your delivery between Feb. 20-24 at Landis House, 67 N. 4th Street, Newport

Eligibility: All students in Kindergarten through 12th grade residing in Perry County or attending a public, private, or home school in Perry County. Works created after February 1, 2023 are eligible. Entries may be submitted on behalf of students by either their teachers or parents. Works created at home are eligible.

Entry Fee: Each school building will receive 20 complimentary entries in 2024. Each additional entry requires a non-refundable \$3 fee.

Registration Form: Please complete the blank excel spreadsheet provided to you by PCCA. Email to yad@perrycountyarts.org. Group projects require an entry fee from each student involved, therefore each student must be listed on a separate line. Students may enter as many categories as they wish, but may only submit one entry per category. See Category Rules/Requirements for details.

Entry Preparation: Literature should include a cover page. Visual art on paper should be affixed to heavyweight paper or mat board, or in a protective frame with no glass. Box canvases should include a hook or wire on the back.

Return of Entries: By default after Youth Art Day, all entries, ribbons and certificates shall be returned to the school listed on the registration form. Teachers are responsible for picking up their school's entries after 3:00 p.m. at Youth Art Day, or making arrangements with another responsible individual to collect or store.
